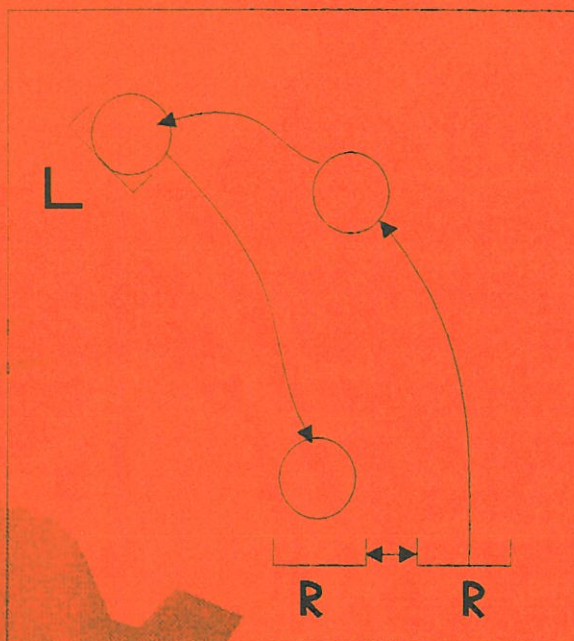
We are now fully paid up UA members, so there.
